1. Victims and survivors of crime will be considered for complete or partial scholarships. **MAXIMUM award is \$1000.**
2. Applicants are asked to write a paragraph explaining the nature of how attendance at the National Association of Victim Service Providers in Corrections, Fifth National Conference will benefit them in their personal healing and recovery, the people they serve, and/or the quality of victim services in their community. Please attach a sheet with the explanation.
3. Applicants are asked to indicate the reason(s) they require financial support in order to attend the training. Please attach a sheet with the reason(s).
4. NAVSPIC is required to collect information from survivor scholarship applicants including year of the crime and type of victimization the victim/survivor experienced.

5. Special consideration will be given to victims and survivors who would not otherwise be able to attend, and those who demonstrate an ability to offer representation from different geographic areas or service provision areas (i.e. homicide, domestic violence, sexual assault, DWI offenses, etc.)
6. Scholarships will be offered based on criteria and availability of funds. Scholarships of up to \$1,000 will be awarded. **Any expenses exceeding this amount will be the responsibility of the individual and/or their agency. This scholarship will be awarded as a reimbursement. Expense reports must be submitted no later than November 21, 2011.**
7. Award recipients will be e-mailed a Feedback Form which you are required to complete and fax or mail to OVC TTAC after attending the conference.
